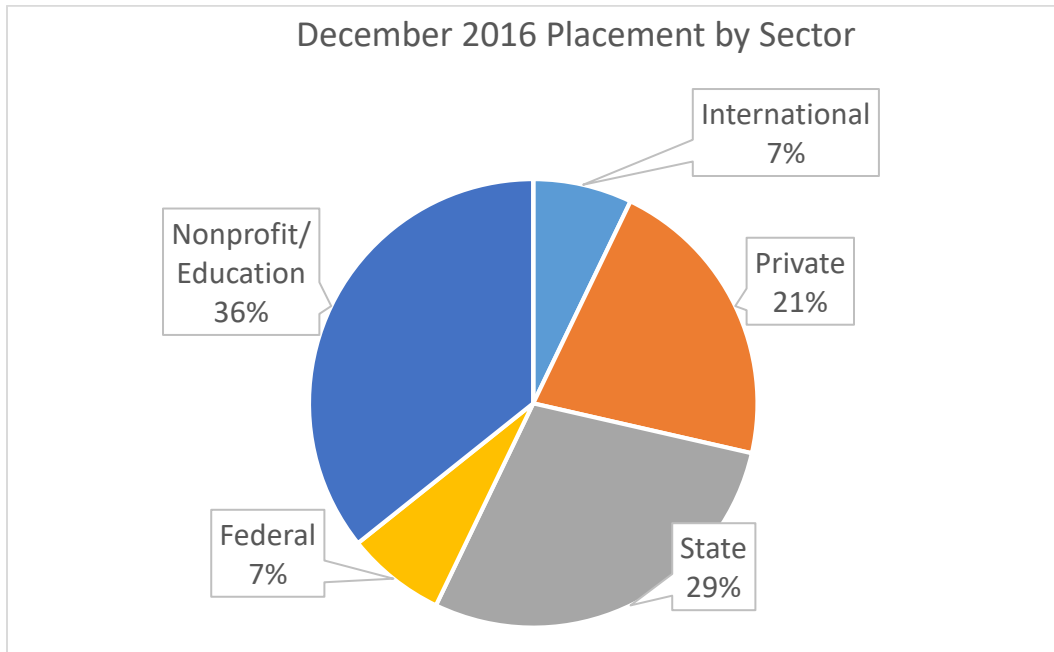


## LFS 6-Month Post-Graduation Career Statistics for the Class of 2016

- Of 35 2016 La Follette School graduates, 30 entered the workforce; 3 sought additional degrees; 2 decided not to join the workforce at this time.<sup>1</sup>
- Of the 30 who reported entering the workforce, 93 percent (28 graduates) reported by December, 2016, that they had secured jobs or internships in their fields
