The La Follette School of Public Affairs is proud to announce the new **Curt and Sue Culver Graduate Fellowship**. The new fund will provide partial 2016-17 tuition funding of \$2,000 to \$6,000 for selected students. The Fund was established to help students based on financial need, academic record and evidence of outside activities serving others.

To be considered, please send an email no longer than three paragraphs, highlighting your service experience and potential plans for the type of career you hope to pursue and your most recent resume by August 22nd. Students will have to submit a FAFSA and show unmet need by August 29th to be considered for this funding. All incoming and continuing students will be considered.

Half of the scholarship will be awarded in the fall and the other half for the spring semester. Recipients must be in good standing in the spring in order to receive the second half of the award.
